QUICK GUIDE TO WORKING EQUITATION LEVELS

Childrens Level - Rider 8 to 13 years of age. Walk/trot only. Dressage test and Ease of Handling obstacle course, NO Speed trial.

Level 1, Introductory - Walk/trot only. Dressage test and Ease of Handling obstacle course, NO Speed trial.

Level 2, Novice A - Trot within some obstacles, canter between obstacles. Includes Dressage test, Ease of Handling obstacle course, and Speed trial.

Level 3, Novice B - Canter within some obstacles, canter between obstacles; change lead through trot. Includes Dressage test, Ease of Handling obstacle course, and Speed trial.

Level 4, Intermediate A - Canter within most obstacles, canter between obstacles; change lead through walk. Includes Dressage test, Ease of Handling obstacle course, and Speed trial.

Level 5, Intermediate B - Canter within most obstacles, canter between obstacles; flying lead changes. Includes Dressage test, Ease of Handling obstacle course, and Speed trial.

Level 6, Advanced - Same as Intermediate B, must be ridden with only one hand on reins.

- Two Full Court Show Dressage Arenas, sand/rubber
- 1 EOH/Speed Arena, sand
- Wash racks available.
- Covered Lunge arena (60 feet)
- Stabling - Box Stalls

2. **Closing date Wednesday prior (received by 7 PM)**
3. Indicate Status: **Amateur, Youth, or Open** and include **SIGNATURE. ONE** horse/rider combination per entry.
4. If entries warrant, Youth, Adult Amateur, Young Horse, and Gaited Horses may be pinned as separate classes. Otherwise, all classes will be run as Open classes
5. Classes may not be run in numerical order.
6. Rules in accordance with WE United
7. Helmet and Boots required, can be ridden in any form of tack within the guidelines of the WE United rulebook.
8. Entries received after closing date and changed entries are subject to a \$10 per class fee.
9. **Entries received without payment will be charged a \$15 incomplete entry fee. This includes phone, fax and email entries. Accepting a late entry, the responsible party will be liable to pay all class, office, stable and other fees. Withdrawing will not excuse payment of fees.**
10. All refunds will incur a \$10 processing fee and released after payment is recovered.
11. Refunds after closing date will be made only if entry is filled from wait list.
12. Entries will be accepted in the order they are received. Due to time constraints, no more than 25 entries will be accepted.
